



## -PROCEDURE/SURGICAL DROP-OFF INSTRUCTIONS-

Dr. Silverman and the dedicated staff here at Sun City Veterinary Surgery Center look forward to serving you and your pet. To help with any concerns or questions you may have regarding your pet's procedure(s), we have compiled this list of instructions.

 Your pet must be dropped off *the day before* any scheduled procedure <u>between</u> <u>1:00PM and 3:00PM</u>, unless otherwise instructed by Dr. Silverman\*. This is to ensure all pre-operative diagnostics (ex: bloodwork, radiographs, etc...) are completed and that your pet is fasted appropriately for anesthetic purposes.

\*If your pet is being dropped off <u>the day of his/her procedure</u>, do not feed your pet any food after 10:00 PM the night before. Water is allowed in the morning. Please be at Sun City Veterinary Surgery Center no later than 8:00 AM.

- 2. Make sure all medications and a few days worth of food servings are dropped off with your pet. Medications need to be in their proper containers with original prescription labels.
- 3. To ease your pet's stress and anxiousness, we recommend bringing a small "comfort" item for them, such as a blanket or toy.

You may feed your pet and give any necessary medications before dropping him/her off for the evening. Please let us know the time(s) you completed these feedings and drug administrations. Once your pet is dropped off, an overnight technician will be available to monitor your pet.
